Mobile learning addresses the challenges of daily English practice. Assembling all students in one place daily for practice proved difficult, making mobile learning the ideal solution, enhancing flexibility and accessibility.

The practice operates through a WhatsApp group, where daily tasks are shared with students. Responses are received via Google Forms. Participation is rewarded with points, which accumulate on a leaderboard and also certificates. Motivating students to engage consistently, and monitoring their participation proved challenging.

Positive feedback and the number certificates awarded, demonstrate their progress. An anthology of student poems was created, highlighting creativity and improved language skills.
